As we enter the 119th Congress, I'm reflecting on our accomplishments from this past Congress and the work ahead in 2025. It's an honor to be your representative, and we've made great progress on behalf of our community in the last two years, including securing \$816 million in federal grant assistance for our district.

My office successfully closed 2,300+ constituent cases, from securing expedited passports for constituents ahead of emergency travel to ensuring our neighbors received the Social Security and other benefits they have earned.

Through our work, my office also secured \$4.3 million in returns this year for our neighbors, easing financial burdens and ensuring that hard-earned money stays where it belongs—in your pockets.

I also held multiple U.S. passport fairs to connect constituents with federal agents who walked them through the application process to be ready for travel.

As founder of the first-ever Congressional Renters Caucus and Dads Caucus, I'll keep working to make sure everyone in CA-34 has the tools they need to thrive.

From tackling the ongoing housing crisis to expanding access to affordable child care, I'm going to continue fighting for you in Congress!

**DeAnna, a constituent from MacArthur Park,** contacted my office regarding assistance with the Social Security Administration (SSA). She informed us she had applied for disability benefits and had been approved, however, the real issue was that she had not received payment. My casework team *quickly* reached out to the SSA, and **I'm happy to report that we helped secure her back pay totaling \$71,134.90.** 

When Della from Koreatown hadn't heard back from U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) regarding her pending application, she contacted my office for help. My team quickly spoke to USCIS to receive an update: Della's application was approved and she is now a permanent resident!





Evelyn from Monterrey Hills called my office when her parents' passports and visitor visas had been stolen in Mexico. My team *quickly* contacted the U.S. Embassy in Mexico and secured an expedited appointment to make sure Evelyn's parents could receive their documents and return home.
