Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Estrada Courts Air Conditioners and Ceiling Fans Phase II project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles located at 2600 Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90057.

The proposed funding will be used to complete Phase II, the final phase, of the Estrada Courts Air Conditioners and Ceiling fans project by installing air conditioning units in living areas and ceiling fans in bedrooms in 414 residential units, while also upgrading each unit's electrical system to support the added A/C units. Federal funds would be used for project design, construction, installation, and related electrical improvements.

This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it makes a direct capital improvement to an existing public housing community that serves 1,048 residents in Boyle Heights. More than 25 percent of Estrada Courts households include children and over 24 percent of residents are elderly. This practical investment will keep residents safe in their homes during increasingly severe summer conditions, improve overall habitability, and reduce the risks associated with inadequate cooling. This project will preserve and upgrade existing housing rather than allowing conditions to worsen and costs to grow.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
