3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protect Vulnerable Im-
5 migrant Youth Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATING CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT-BASED VISA**
2 **CAPS.**

3 (a) ALIENS NOT SUBJECT TO DIRECT NUMERICAL
4 LIMITATIONS.—Section 201(b)(1)(A) of the Immigration
5 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1151(b)(1)(A)) is amended
6 by striking “subparagraph (A) or (B)” and inserting
7 “subparagraph (A), (B), or (J)”.

8 (b) PREFERENCE ALLOCATION FOR EMPLOYMENT-
9 BASED IMMIGRANTS.—Section 203(b)(4) of the Immigra-
10 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(b)(4)) is amend-
11 ed by striking “subparagraph (A) or (B)” and inserting
12 “subparagraph (A), (B), or (J)”.
