Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Spring Street Park Improvements project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Los Angeles located at 200 N Main St Suite 1500, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

The proposed funding would be used to make targeted capital improvements to restore the park as a safe, accessible, and functional neighborhood greenspace. The project would support eligible site, and public facility upgrades such as replacement of deteriorated playground equipment, ADA and safety improvements, lighting and sanitation-related infrastructure, regular park maintenance and other rehabilitation needed to address longstanding public safety and maintenance concerns.

This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it would support targeted restoration for a critical neighborhood public living space in Downtown Los Angeles. Investments such as playground replacement, restroom installation, ADA and safety upgrades, general site rehabilitation, and regular park maintenance would work to address longstanding public safety and sanitation concerns while improving accessibility and usability for residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
